## AI programs continue to be popular for most partners!

- We've made note of additional AI suggestions, including AI & Our Planet
- Getting questions you can't answer in an AI lecture is typical. Use the opportunity to demonstrate how to search for information. You can ask AI! Be sure to model how to write strong prompts that ask for sources, different viewpoints, etc.

## Smartphone programs are also very popular

- Using your iPhone and Using your Android Smartphone are 10-session program series that focus on using your phone.
- Available in English now, in Spanish in Q1 2026. (Chinese planned later in 2026, so stay tuned!)
- The individual lectures and workshops that make up the series are also available as one-offs.

## Requests for more visible dates on program files

- We've noted this request and will work with the licensing team to evaluate it.
- Keep in mind that while technology moves fast, we design programs to be as evergreen as possible.
- We hope the date on the program is not the primary factor in whether you offer it, but we know that it's helpful to know, especially when preparing to teach.
- All slides, handouts, and course books have copyright dates. In trainer guides and course syllabi, we aim to include the date for listed prices, stats, etc.
- When a website or app looks different than the program materials, trainers can use this as a teaching opportunity about how to adapt to tech updates.



## Request for trainer guides in other languages

- This is not possible right now.
- We recognize the English trainer guides mean that trainers teaching in other languages have different steps for prep, which may require more time as well.
